DMSC62 Course Update – March 2025

This course update is for all delegates currently booked on or interested in our course 'DMSC62, Composites for Engineers & designers, Stage 2 - Advanced Design.'

Having broken down composites to an intuitive approach to the materials and processes in our stage 1 course, we have left many delegates at the end of the stage 1 course wanting to know even more. This has often led to many after course discussions (as well as a lot of consultancy work for us) including problem solving, prototyping, tooling production through to complete design & development projects.

We have found, during our consultancy work, delegates are able to understand our approach and gain further mentoring. However, many who have attended our DMSC61 course are not involved directly in composite design, but are actively involved in composite production, addressing production problems, discussing composites with sub-suppliers and more on a regular basis.

We have not removed any technical content from our stage 2 course but we have re-arranged it, added further content and revised some of the practical tasks accordingly. To this extent, our stage 2 course better reflects the way in which we take a holistic approach to anything composites and is aligned to current industry thinking for the future.

The course is suitable for anyone involved in composite design as well as anyone who is regularly involved in technical composites. The course still follows a structured problem solving approach during the practical sessions, which has been proven in accelerating prior delegates further understanding of composites. During exhibitions and conferences, we are regularly approached by past delegates who have attended our courses at some time in the last two decades, and have continue to move onwards and upwards in composites.
